

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 76

Reps. BeGole, Alexander, Fox, Greene, Rigas, Schuette and Woolford offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to commend President Donald J. Trump for his
2 leadership and accomplishments during his first one hundred days in
3 office, recognize the positive impact of his actions on the state
4 of Michigan and the nation, and extend to him our gratitude and
5 best wishes for continued success.

6 Whereas, President Donald J. Trump's first one hundred days in
7 office marked a decisive return to pro-growth, pro-security, and
8 America first policies, setting a new course for the nation that
9 has had a direct and positive impact on the state of Michigan; and

10 Whereas, President Trump has delivered on his commitments to
11 the American people by renegotiating unfair trade deals,
12 eliminating wasteful spending, securing the border, taking action
13 to prevent the flow of fentanyl into Michigan communities and

1 advancing policies that directly benefit Michigan's economy,
2 manufacturing sector, and working families; and

3 Whereas, In these first one hundred days, the Trump
4 Administration issued tariffs on countries that had established
5 unfair trade terms with the United States, strengthening domestic
6 manufacturing, including Michigan's automotive and manufacturing
7 industries, and delivering a tangible impact for Michigan workers
8 and their families by protecting jobs, supporting local economies,
9 and reinforcing the livelihoods of the people who power our state;
10 and

11 Whereas, One hundred days into his second term, President
12 Trump traveled to Michigan to announce a new F-15EX Eagle II
13 fighter mission with twenty-one aircraft at Selfridge Air National
14 Guard Base, a key national defense hub and economic anchor that
15 supports thousands of jobs and military families in Michigan and
16 the nation; and

17 Whereas, President Trump has demonstrated his commitment to
18 Michigan's natural resources by publicly promising to prevent Asian
19 carp from entering the Great Lakes and supporting the Brandon Road
20 Interbasin Project, critical to protecting Michigan's waters and
21 economy; and

22 Whereas, President Trump's Executive Order, declaring a
23 National Energy Emergency, has allowed for emergency permitting of
24 the proposed Enbridge Line 5 tunnel project, securing Michigan's
25 energy infrastructure and protecting thousands of Michigan jobs;
26 and

27 Whereas, The Department of Government Efficiency has
28 identified over \$160 billion in government waste and fraud, the
29 elimination of unnecessary agencies, the cancellation of wasteful

1 grants and contracts, and the dismantling of politicized diversity,
2 equity, and inclusion initiatives across federal agencies – freeing
3 up resources to prioritize infrastructure, energy, agriculture, and
4 national defense projects critical to the country; and

5 Whereas, President Trump has followed through with his pledge
6 to secure our border and protect our communities by deploying
7 troops to the border, preventing illegal immigration, and
8 partnering with state and local enforcement officers to remove
9 dangerous illegal aliens – resulting in a 95% reduction in illegal
10 border encounters and the arrest of over 150,000 illegal aliens;
11 and

12 Whereas, President Trump's Executive Order to increase
13 American mineral production has expedited permitting for a proposed
14 mine in Osceola County, which will reduce reliance on foreign
15 potash and prioritize the nation's and Michigan's critical potash
16 reserve; and

17 Whereas, President Trump celebrated the success of his first
18 one hundred days by visiting Macomb County on April 29, 2025, and
19 highlighting the important role the state of Michigan plays in the
20 success of his policies and direction for the country; now
21 therefore, be it

22 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
23 this legislative body commend President Donald J. Trump for his
24 leadership and accomplishments during his first 100 days in office,
25 recognize the positive impact of his actions on the state of
26 Michigan and the nation, and extend to him our gratitude and best
27 wishes for continued success; and be it further
