- 11 Whereas, Emergency medical services has grown to fill a gap by
- 12 providing important, out-of-hospital care, including preventative

medicine, follow-up care, and access to telemedicine; and 1 Whereas, The emergency medical services system consists of 2 first responders, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, 3 emergency medical dispatchers, firefighters, police officers, 4 educators, administrators, pre-hospital nurses, emergency nurses, 5 6 emergency physicians, trained members of the public, and other out-7 of-hospital medical care providers; and 8 Whereas, The members of emergency medical services teams, 9 whether career or volunteer, engage in thousands of hours of 10 specialized training and continuing education to enhance their 11 lifesaving skills; and Whereas, It is appropriate to recognize the value and the 12 accomplishments of emergency medical services providers by 13 designating the Emergency Medical Services Week; now, therefore, be 14 15 it 16 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of this legislative body declare May 18-24, 2025, as Emergency Medical 17 18 Services Week in the state of Michigan.
