- A resolution to declare May 2025 as Asian Pacific American
 Heritage Month in the state of Michigan.
- Whereas, The state of Michigan is fortunate to be home to more than 330,000 residents of Asian and Pacific Island descent; and
- 5 Whereas, Asian Pacific Americans comprise one of the fastest-
- ${f 6}$ growing populations in both the state and the nation. In fact, this
- 7 group is the largest-growing population in Michigan according to
- 8 the last U.S. Census; and
- 9 Whereas, The Asian and Pacific Island regions are tremendously
- 10 diverse, with more than thirty countries, numerous languages, and

- 2 Whereas, Citizens of Asian and Pacific Island descent in each
- 3 generation, from the laborers who connected our coasts one and a
- 4 half centuries ago to the patriots who fought overseas while their
- 5 families were interned at home, to the entrepreneurs and engineers
- 6 who help our economy thrive, and our healthcare professionals who
- 7 serve to ensure public health. These patriotic Americans enhance
- 8 our culture, quality of life, and economic vitality through
- 9 leadership, commitments to knowledge, education, and advancement,
- 10 and dedication to their communities; and
- 11 Whereas, The state of Michigan and the United States of
- 12 America have been enriched by the contributions of Asian Pacific
- 13 Americans in all facets of life, including the arts, sciences,
- 14 business, education, and philanthropy. Michigan has recognized the
- 15 contributions Asian Pacific Americans make to our state with the
- 16 establishment of the Michigan Asian Pacific American Affairs
- 17 Commission; and
- 18 Whereas, The culture and contributions of our Asian and
- 19 Pacific Island residents will continue to grow in significance as
- 20 more Asian Pacific Americans choose to make Michigan their home and
- 21 as our economy becomes increasingly intertwined with the economies
- 22 throughout Asia; and
- 23 Whereas, Asian Pacific Americans, through advocating issues of
- 24 justice and equality, continue to break down the barriers of
- 25 discrimination, indifference, and intolerance, thereby opening
- 26 doors for all Asian Pacific Americans; and
- Whereas, Asian Pacific American residents are proudly served
- 28 in Michigan by many dedicated organizations, including Asian
- 29 Pacific American Chamber of Commerce, Council of Asian Pacific

- 7 Whereas, The state of Michigan takes pride in its cultural
- 8 diversity and welcomes the opportunity to honor our Asian Pacific
- 9 American residents for their lasting, expanding imprint upon our
- 10 state; now, therefore, be it
- 11 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 12 this legislative body declare May 2025 as Asian Pacific American
- 13 Heritage Month in the state of Michigan. We encourage all citizens
- 14 to celebrate the individual and collective contributions of Asian
- 15 Pacific Americans to this state and to this country.
