- Whereas, Uterine fibroids, also known as leiomyomas or myomas,
- 4 are noncancerous tumors of the uterus that affect up to 70 percent
- 5 of women by age 50, with the highest incidence among African
- 6 American women; and
- 7 Whereas, Uterine fibroids can cause significant and life-
- 8 altering symptoms, including excessive menstrual bleeding, pelvic
- 9 pain, frequent urination, fatigue, anemia, infertility, and
- 10 complications during pregnancy; and
- 11 Whereas, Fibroids are the leading cause of hysterectomies in
- 12 the United States, resulting in tens of thousands of surgeries each

- 1 year that may have long-term physical and emotional consequences
- 2 for patients; and
- 3 Whereas, Despite the prevalence and impact of fibroids, there
- 4 remains a lack of awareness, funding, research, and accessible
- 5 treatment options for women, particularly in underserved and
- 6 minority communities; and
- 7 Whereas, Fibroids Awareness Month is an opportunity to raise
- 8 public awareness, promote early diagnosis, encourage research, and
- 9 reduce the stigma and disparities associated with this condition;

- 11 Whereas, Community advocates, healthcare professionals, and
- 12 nonprofit organizations play a critical role in supporting
- 13 individuals affected by fibroids through education, outreach, and
- 14 advocacy efforts; now, therefore, be it
