SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 44

Senators Johnson, Geiss, Lauwers, McMorrow, Santana and Theis offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to designate May 2025 as Motorcycle Safety
- 2 Awareness Month.
- 3 Whereas, Michigan has nearly 250,000 registered motorcycles
- 4 and more than 610,000 individuals who have operator licenses with a
- 5 motorcycle endorsement; and
- 6 Whereas, The safe operation of a motorcycle requires the use
- 7 of special skills developed through a combination of training and
- 8 expertise, the use of good judgment, plus a thorough knowledge of
- 9 traffic laws and licensing requirements; and
- 10 Whereas, The use of proper protective riding apparel is an
- 11 important part of a motorcycle operator's responsibility; and
- 12 Whereas, Motorcycle safety awareness advocacy is a cooperative
- 13 effort to decrease the number of injuries and fatalities associated

- 1 with motorcycling; and
- 2 Whereas, The promotion of motorcycle rider education programs
- 3 available through the Michigan Department of State, including
- 4 recommendations that motorcycle operators wear the proper gear, in
- 5 addition to driving their vehicles defensively and cautiously, is
- 6 intended to reduce the number of crashes; and
- 7 Whereas, The emergence of spring is synonymous with the return
- 8 of motorcycle enthusiasts to our state's roadways. Throughout
- 9 Michigan, motorcyclists have been on the cutting edge of supporting
- 10 the wise and sensible use of this enjoyable mode of travel; and
- 11 Whereas, Indeed, the disproportionate number of motorcycle
- 12 fatalities make it vitally important to encourage motorcyclists to
- 13 understand and practice the highest degree of safety. It is also
- 14 important to remind other drivers that highway safety is beneficial
- 15 to all parties traveling on public roadways; and
- 16 Whereas, Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month encourages
- 17 motorcycle operators to don proper protective riding attire,
- 18 maintain their motorcycles using safety and maintenance checks
- 19 found in the owner's manual, abide by the laws of the road, and
- 20 implement operating techniques providing an additional standard of
- 21 safety; and
- Whereas, Car and truck drivers are informed of the fact that
- 23 motorcyclists are resuming their travels on our public roadways and
- 24 each is advised to be exceptionally vigilant and watchful when
- 25 approaching or passing a motorcycle on the highway and to "look
- 26 twice to save a life"; now, therefore, be it
- 27 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 28 body designate May 2025 as Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month. We
- 29 encourage all of Michigan's citizens to participate in the aims and

1 goals of this effort.
