

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 58

Senators Lindsey, Outman, Bayer, Damoose, Lauwers, Moss, Theis, Webber and Wojno offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to commemorate the 250th anniversary of the
2 United States (U.S.) Army.

3 Whereas, June 14, 2025, marks the 250th anniversary of the
4 founding of the U.S. Army in 1775 when the Continental Congress
5 established the first Continental Army and named George Washington,
6 Commander-in-Chief; and

7 Whereas, The Continental Army proudly served from 1775 to
8 1783, defeating British tyranny and ushering in an era of American
9 independence. In 1783, the U.S. Army officially debuted to the
10 world; and

11 Whereas, The mission of the U.S. Army is to deploy, fight, and
12 win our nation's wars by securing ready, prompt, and sustained land
13 dominance by Army forces across the full spectrum of conflict as

1 part of the joint force; and

2 Whereas, Today, the U.S. Army is the most powerful and
3 effective land force in the world. It is a ready-to-fight force
4 that is experienced, lethal, and trained to conduct any mission,
5 anywhere, in support of our nation's security; and

6 Whereas, The Army's greatest asset is our people - the finest
7 men and women our great nation has to offer - with a myriad of
8 talents that make us strong; and

9 Whereas, From the Revolutionary War onward, our warfighters
10 have consistently demonstrated their resolve to defend freedom at
11 home and abroad; now, therefore, be it

12 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
13 body commemorate the 250th anniversary of the United States (U.S.)
14 Army. We commend all the work they have done to defend our nation.
