- 4 founding of the U.S. Army in 1775 when the Continental Congress
- 5 established the first Continental Army and named George Washington,
- 6 Commander-in-Chief; and
- 7 Whereas, The Continental Army proudly served from 1775 to
- 8 1783, defeating British tyranny and ushering in an era of American
- 9 independence. In 1783, the U.S. Army officially debuted to the
- 10 world; and
- 11 Whereas, The mission of the U.S. Army is to deploy, fight, and
- 12 win our nation's wars by securing ready, prompt, and sustained land
- 13 dominance by Army forces across the full spectrum of conflict as

- 1 part of the joint force; and
- Whereas, Today, the U.S. Army is the most powerful and
- 3 effective land force in the world. It is a ready-to-fight force
- 4 that is experienced, lethal, and trained to conduct any mission,
- 5 anywhere, in support of our nation's security; and
- 6 Whereas, The Army's greatest asset is our people the finest
- 7 men and women our great nation has to offer with a myriad of
- 8 talents that make us strong; and
- 9 Whereas, From the Revolutionary War onward, our warfighters
- 10 have consistently demonstrated their resolve to defend freedom at
- 11 home and abroad; now, therefore, be it
- 12 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 13 body commemorate the 250th anniversary of the United States (U.S.)
- 14 Army. We commend all the work they have done to defend our nation.
