HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 74

Rep. B. Carter offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare April 2025 as Handwriting Month in the state of Michigan. 2 Whereas, The ability to read and write is a fundamental aspect 3 4 of American society and culture; and 5 Whereas, A 2024 study has shown that writing down information, as opposed to typing information, leads to better overall brain 6 connectivity and memory, especially for school-age children; and 7 Whereas, Ensuring students have access to writing education 8 will enhance their literacy skills, support their academic 9 10 achievement, and preserve an essential mode of written communication for future generations; and 11 12 Whereas, Handwriting is recognized by educators throughout the 13 world as an important component of a child's education; and 14 Whereas, In addition to the importance of writing education,

- 1 research has shown that learning cursive writing enhances cognitive
- 2 development and improves fine motor skills, which supports both
- 3 reading comprehension and written communication; and
- 4 Whereas, The ability to write a cursive signature is needed on
- 5 many documents, including mortgages, student loans, checks, deeds,
- 6 titles, and more; and
- 7 Whereas, The founding documents of our great nation, including
- 8 the Declaration of Independence, the United States Constitution,
- 9 and the Bill of Rights, are written in cursive; and
- 10 Whereas, John Hancock, a great patriot from the Commonwealth
- 11 of Massachusetts, served as President of the Continental Congress
- 12 (1775-1777) and Governor of Massachusetts (1780-1785) and, in 1776
- 13 became the first to sign the Declaration of Independence, leaving a
- 14 large and prominent signature that made "John Hancock" synonymous
- 15 with handwritten signatures and the importance of penmanship in
- 16 American history; and
- 17 Whereas, The date of Hancock's birth, January 23, 1737, has
- 18 been recognized as National Handwriting Day since 1977, as first
- 19 promoted by the Writing Instrument Manufacturers Association to
- 20 honor the enduring significance of handwriting in civic life; now,
- 21 therefore, be it
- 22 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 23 this legislative body declare April 2025 as Handwriting Month in
- 24 the state of Michigan. We strongly support the ability of all
- 25 children to perform their own research, read, and write.
