

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 76

Rep. BeGole offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to commend President Donald J. Trump for his
2 leadership and accomplishments during his first one hundred days in
3 office, recognize the positive impact of his actions on the state
4 of Michigan and the nation, and extend to him our gratitude and
5 best wishes for continued success.

6 Whereas, President Donald J. Trump's first one hundred days in
7 office marked a decisive return to pro-growth, pro-security, and
8 America first policies, setting a new course for the nation that
9 has had a direct and positive impact on the state of Michigan; and

10 Whereas, President Trump has delivered on his commitments to
11 the American people by renegotiating unfair trade deals,
12 eliminating wasteful spending, securing the border, taking action
13 to prevent the flow of fentanyl into Michigan communities and
14 advancing policies that directly benefit Michigan's economy,

1 manufacturing sector, and working families; and

2 Whereas, In these first one hundred days, the Trump
3 Administration issued tariffs on countries that had established
4 unfair trade terms with the United States, strengthening domestic
5 manufacturing, including Michigan's automotive and manufacturing
6 industries, and delivering a tangible impact for Michigan workers
7 and their families by protecting jobs, supporting local economies,
8 and reinforcing the livelihoods of the people who power our state;
9 and

10 Whereas, One hundred days into his second term, President
11 Trump traveled to Michigan to announce a new F-15EX Eagle II
12 fighter mission with twenty-one aircraft at Selfridge Air National
13 Guard Base, a key national defense hub and economic anchor that
14 supports thousands of jobs and military families in Michigan and
15 the nation; and

16 Whereas, President Trump has demonstrated his commitment to
17 Michigan's natural resources by publicly promising to prevent Asian
18 carp from entering the Great Lakes and supporting the Brandon Road
19 Interbasin Project, critical to protecting Michigan's waters and
20 economy; and

21 Whereas, President Trump's Executive Order, declaring a
22 National Energy Emergency, has allowed for emergency permitting of
23 the proposed Enbridge Line 5 tunnel project, securing Michigan's
24 energy infrastructure and protecting thousands of Michigan jobs;
25 and

26 Whereas, The Department of Government Efficiency has
27 identified over \$160 billion in government waste and fraud, the
28 elimination of unnecessary agencies, the cancellation of wasteful
29 grants and contracts, and the dismantling of politicized diversity,

1 equity, and inclusion initiatives across federal agencies – freeing
2 up resources to prioritize infrastructure, energy, agriculture, and
3 national defense projects critical to the country; and

4 Whereas, President Trump has followed through with his pledge
5 to secure our border and protect our communities by deploying
6 troops to the border, preventing illegal immigration, and
7 partnering with state and local enforcement officers to remove
8 dangerous illegal aliens – resulting in a 95% reduction in illegal
9 border encounters and the arrest of over 150,000 illegal aliens;
10 and

11 Whereas, President Trump’s Executive Order to increase
12 American mineral production has expedited permitting for a proposed
13 mine in Osceola County, which will reduce reliance on foreign
14 potash and prioritize the nation’s and Michigan’s critical potash
15 reserve; and

16 Whereas, President Trump celebrated the success of his first
17 one hundred days by visiting Macomb County on April 29, 2025, and
18 highlighting the important role the state of Michigan plays in the
19 success of his policies and direction for the country; now
20 therefore, be it

21 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
22 this legislative body commend President Donald J. Trump for his
23 leadership and accomplishments during his first 100 days in office,
24 recognize the positive impact of his actions on the state of
25 Michigan and the nation, and extend to him our gratitude and best
26 wishes for continued success; and be it further
