## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 107

Reps. Wortz, Fox, Schmaltz and Bruck offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the end of
- 2 the Vietnam War and to declare May 15, 2025, as Vietnam Veterans'
- 3 Heritage Day in the state of Michigan.
- 4 Whereas, The Mayaguez Incident, which ended on May 15th, 1975,
- 5 is often regarded as the last U.S. military action in the Vietnam
- 6 War, during which some of the final service members whose names are
- 7 engraved on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C., were
- 8 killed: and
- 9 Whereas, Over 2.7 million U.S. military personnel served in
- 10 Vietnam during the war and over 58,000 of them gave their lives for
- 11 their country; and
- 12 Whereas, Vietnam veterans were often met with scorn and

- 1 disrespect upon their return home due to the controversial nature
- 2 of the war, rather than being honored and celebrated for their
- 3 sacrifice. Furthermore, many Vietnam veterans have struggled to
- 4 readjust to civilian life, suffering from a variety of physical and
- 5 psychological conditions; and
- 6 Whereas, More Vietnam veterans have died from suicide than
- 7 died in combat, with recent estimates nearing 100,000; and
- 8 Whereas, It is our duty as residents of the state of Michigan
- 9 and citizens of the United States to hold in high regard those who
- 10 have fought in the armed forces, to honor the sacrifice of those
- 11 who gave their lives, and to pass along to the next generation an
- 12 honor for all who have served their country; now, therefore, be it
- 13 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 14 this legislative body commemorate the 50th anniversary of the end
- 15 of the Vietnam War and declare May 15, 2025, as Vietnam Veterans'
- 16 Heritage Day in the state of Michigan.
