

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 108

Rep. Prestin offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to declare May 18-24, 2025, as Emergency Medical
2 Services Week in the state of Michigan.

3 Whereas, Emergency medical services is a vital public service;
4 and

5 Whereas, The members of emergency medical services teams are
6 ready to provide lifesaving care to those in need 24 hours a day,
7 seven days a week; and

8 Whereas, Access to quality emergency care dramatically
9 improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience
10 sudden illness or injury; and

11 Whereas, Emergency medical services has grown to fill a gap by
12 providing important, out-of-hospital care, including preventative
13 medicine, follow-up care, and access to telemedicine; and

14 Whereas, The emergency medical services system consists of

1 first responders, emergency medical technicians, paramedics,
2 emergency medical dispatchers, firefighters, police officers,
3 educators, administrators, pre-hospital nurses, emergency nurses,
4 emergency physicians, trained members of the public, and other out-
5 of-hospital medical care providers; and

6 Whereas, The members of emergency medical services teams,
7 whether career or volunteer, engage in thousands of hours of
8 specialized training and continuing education to enhance their
9 lifesaving skills; and

10 Whereas, It is appropriate to recognize the value and the
11 accomplishments of emergency medical services providers by
12 designating the Emergency Medical Services Week; now, therefore, be
13 it

14 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
15 this legislative body declare May 18-24, 2025, as Emergency Medical
16 Services Week in the state of Michigan. We encourage communities
17 across the state to observe this week with appropriate programs,
18 ceremonies, and activities.
