These patriotic Americans enhance 7 our culture, quality of life, and economic vitality through 8 leadership, commitments to knowledge, education, and advancement, 9 and dedication to their communities; and 10 Whereas, The state of Michigan and the United States of 11 America have been enriched by the contributions of Asian Pacific Americans in all facets of life, including the arts, sciences, 12 business, education, and philanthropy.
