## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 135

Reps. Pohutsky, McFall, Arbit, Weiss, Rheingans and Martus offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to urge the United States Congress, the President
- 2 of the United States, and the Secretary of the United States
- 3 Department of Health and Human Services to take all necessary
- 4 actions to support and ensure the provision of free and accessible
- 5 COVID-19 vaccines for all.
- 6 Whereas, The COVID-19 pandemic resulted in the deaths of over
- 7 one million Americans and disrupted the lives, health, and economic
- 8 well-being of millions more. As a response to the pandemic, safe
- 9 and effective vaccines were developed and authorized by the Food
- 10 and Drug Administration to combat COVID-19 and its variants,
- 11 significantly reducing severe illness, hospitalizations, and
- 12 deaths; and
- 13 Whereas, Widespread access to COVID-19 vaccines is essential

- 1 for protecting public health, supporting economic recovery, and
- 2 preventing future waves of infection. It is critical that COVID-19
- 3 vaccines remain free and accessible to every person in the United
- 4 States, regardless of income, insurance status, or immigration
- 5 status; and
- 6 Whereas, Despite the demonstrated benefits of vaccination,
- 7 access remains unequal due to socioeconomic disparities, geographic
- 8 challenges, and the expiration of federal funding that once
- 9 guaranteed free vaccine availability. Additionally, public
- 10 confidence in vaccines has been undermined by misinformation,
- 11 placing individuals and communities at risk; and
- 12 Whereas, Elected officials and public figures bear a
- 13 responsibility to promote public health, support science-based
- 14 policies, and advocate for equitable access to medical resources,
- 15 including vaccines. These individuals should support and advocate
- 16 for universal vaccine access and refrain from promoting
- 17 misinformation that undermines confidence in lifesaving public
- 18 health measures. This is especially true of the Secretary of the
- 19 United States Department of Health and Human Services; now,
- 20 therefore, be it
- 21 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we urge the
- 22 United States Congress, the President of the United States, and the
- 23 Secretary of the United States Department of Health and Human
- 24 Services to take all necessary actions to support and ensure the
- 25 provision of free and accessible COVID-19 vaccines for all; and be
- 26 it further
- 27 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 28 President of the United States, the Speaker of the United States
- 29 House of Representatives, the Majority Leader of the United States

- 1 Senate, and the Secretary of the United States Department of Health
