

**THE HUMAN CLONING FUNDING PROHIBITION ACT**  
**Act 111 of 1998**

AN ACT to prohibit the expenditure of state funds for the purpose of human cloning.

*The People of the State of Michigan enact:*

**333.26401 Short title.**

Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as “the human cloning funding prohibition act”.

**333.26402 “Human cloning” defined.**

Sec. 2. As used in this act, “human cloning” means that term as defined in section 16274 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.16274.

**333.26403 Human cloning; prohibited conduct.**

Sec. 3. A person shall not use state funds to engage in or attempt to engage in human cloning.

**333.26404 Exception.**

Sec. 4. Section 3 does not prohibit the use of state funds for scientific research or cell-based therapies not specifically prohibited by that section.

**333.26405 Private right of action.**

Sec. 5. This act does not give a person a private right of action.

**333.26406 Violation; penalty.**

Sec. 6. A person who violates section 3 is subject to a civil fine of \$10,000,000.00. A civil fine imposed under this section shall be distributed in the same manner in which penal fines are distributed in this state.
