256.607 Student instruction records.

Sec. 7. (1) A driver training school licensed by the department shall maintain a record of instructions given to each student. The record shall contain:

- (a) The name of the school.
- (b) The name of the student.
- (c) The type and date of instruction given, signed by the instructor.
- (d) The fees or tuition charged and the payments made.
- (e) A signed copy of any contract made with a student.

(2) The student instruction records shall be kept on file for a period of 3 calendar years after the student has ceased taking instruction at or with the school. The records shall be open to inspection of the department or its authorized representative at all reasonable times.
