## 257.1820.added Stop-arm camera system.

Sec. 20. (1) A school bus may be equipped with a stop-arm camera system in accordance with this section.

- (2) A school may do either of the following:
- (a) Install and operate a stop-arm camera system on a school bus.
- (b) Enter into a contract with a private vendor to install and operate a stop-arm camera system on a school bus.
- (3) As used in this section, "stop-arm camera system" means a system of 2 or more cameras affixed to a school bus that meets all of the following requirements:
- (a) Is synchronized to automatically record video or 1 or more sequenced photographs of a vehicle failing to stop for a school bus or passing a school bus in violation of section 682(1) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.682.
  - (b) Is capable of capturing images of all of the following:
  - (i) The vehicle.
  - (ii) The registration plate on the rear of the vehicle.
  - (iii) A distance of not less than 200 feet in front of the school bus.
  - (c) Records the date, time, and location on an image produced by the system.
