

U.S. LAND ACQUISITION (EXCERPT)
Act 3 of 1942 (1st Ex. Sess.)

3.201 Acquisition of land by United States for certain purposes; consent of state; storing, depositing, or dumping radioactive material.

Sec. 1. The consent of the state of Michigan is hereby given in accordance with clause 17 of section 8 of article 1 of the constitution of the United States, to the acquisition by the United States, by purchase, condemnation or otherwise, of any land in this state which has been, or may hereafter be acquired for forts, magazines, arsenals, dockyards, and other needful buildings. The state of Michigan does not give consent to the acquisition by the United States by purchase, condemnation, or otherwise of any land or building for use of storing, depositing, or dumping any radioactive material.
