324.44515 Rules requiring equipment and minimum safety standards for livery boats.

Sec. 44515.

The department shall promulgate rules requiring equipment and minimum safety standards for livery boats that are rented or leased to the public by boat liveryes. The rules shall be for the purpose of ensuring the safety of those persons utilizing the facilities of boat liveryes and shall include all of the following:

- (a) Safe operation standards.
- (b) Maximum vessel load capacity.
- (c) Maximum horsepower of any motor to be used to propel the vessel.
- (d) Required equipment and equipment standards to ensure the safety of the general public.
