## 35.112 Determination of eligibility by Michigan veterans' trust fund board of trustees; compensation for services prohibited; rules; appropriations; notice of eligibility; reapplication for benefits.

Sec. 2. (1) The Michigan veterans' trust fund board of trustees shall determine the eligibility of a person who may make application for the benefits provided in section 1 and shall satisfy itself of the attendance and progress of that person at the institution and of the accuracy of the charge or charges submitted to the board by the authorities of the institution on account of the person's attendance at the institution. A member of the board or the secretary shall not receive compensation for the services. The board of trustees shall promulgate rules pursuant to Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, as amended, being sections 24.201 to 24.315 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, to provide uniform consideration of persons who are eligible for the benefits of this act. The appropriations provided to the institutions or state board of education for this purpose shall be made to the Michigan veterans' trust fund board of trustees.

(2) The Michigan veterans' trust fund board of trustees shall notify each person who, before the effective date of this subsection, was determined to be ineligible for benefits provided in section 1 because the person was the child of a veteran who, as the result of wartime service, had been totally disabled, but had died before the person made his or her application. The notice shall advise the person that he or she may be eligible for and may reapply for benefits provided in section 1.
