The provisions of 49 C.F.R. 391.21 relating to application for employment, 49 C.F.R. 391.23 relating to investigations and inquiries, 49 C.F.R. 391.31 relating to road tests, 49 C.F.R. 391.41 to 391.45 to the extent that they require a driver to be medically qualified or examined and to have a medical examiner's certificate on his or her person, and section 2 relating to the maintenance of files and records do not apply to a farm vehicle driver as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5.
